Meals

Schedule

Children have a set schedule each day that includes limited optional elective time.

Middlers and Senior Highs have the opportunity to choose their own elective classes in addition to their required small group and choir rehearsals. Classes are scheduled from 8:00 am to 3:20 pm daily. At 3:30 and 4:30, they may choose to participate in intergenerational classes or free time recreation.
